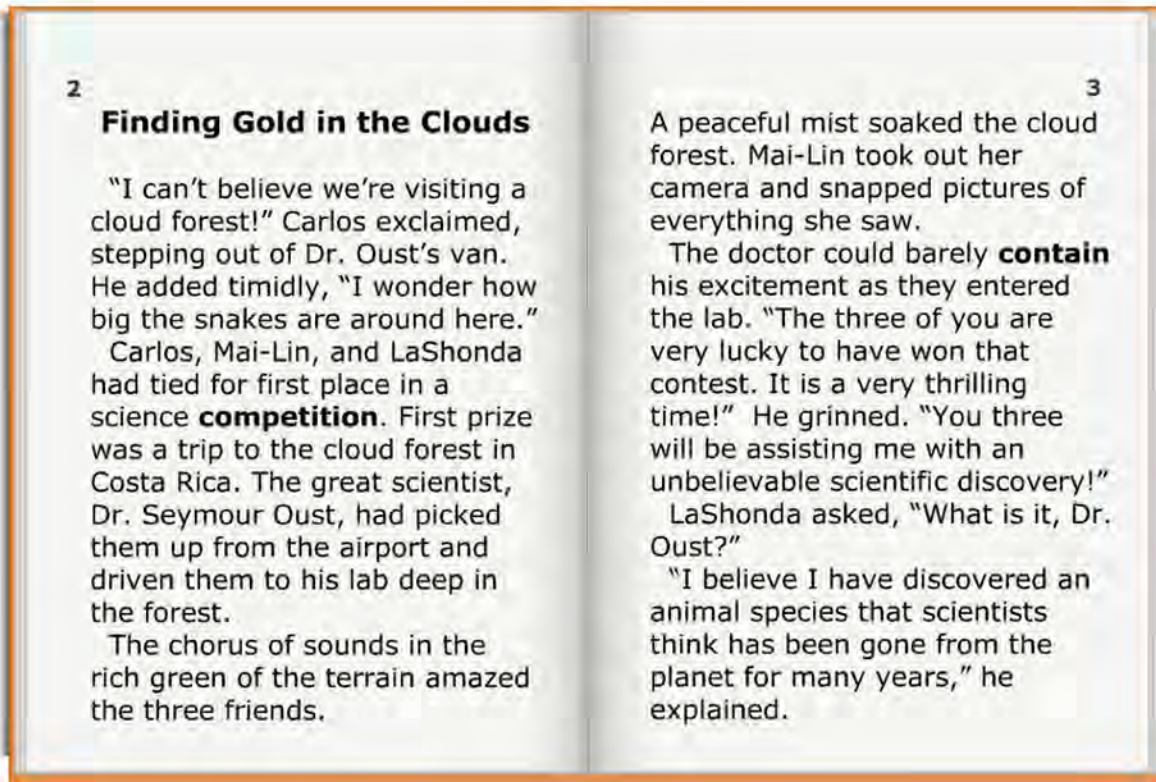

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The kids are going to be involved with some kind of scientific discovery. Maybe it's about some kind of plant or animal. What do you think?

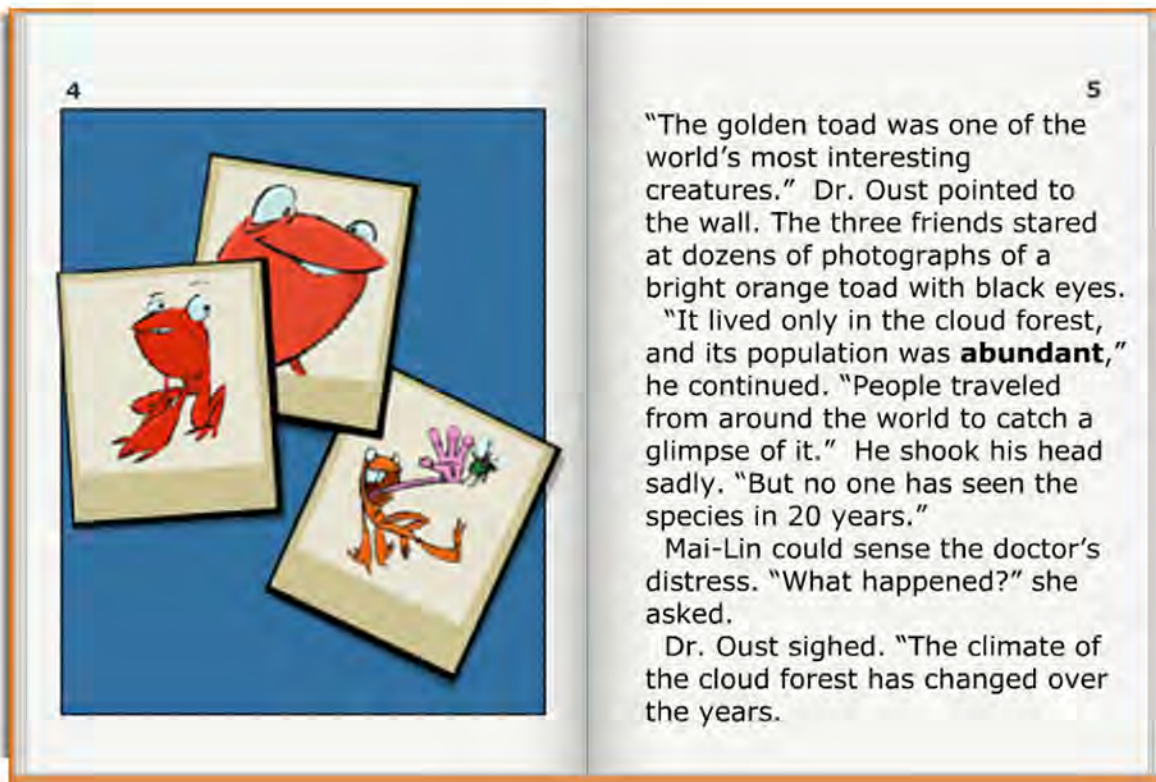

The scientist seems upset about the extinction of the Gold Toad. Why would it matter if a species became extinct?

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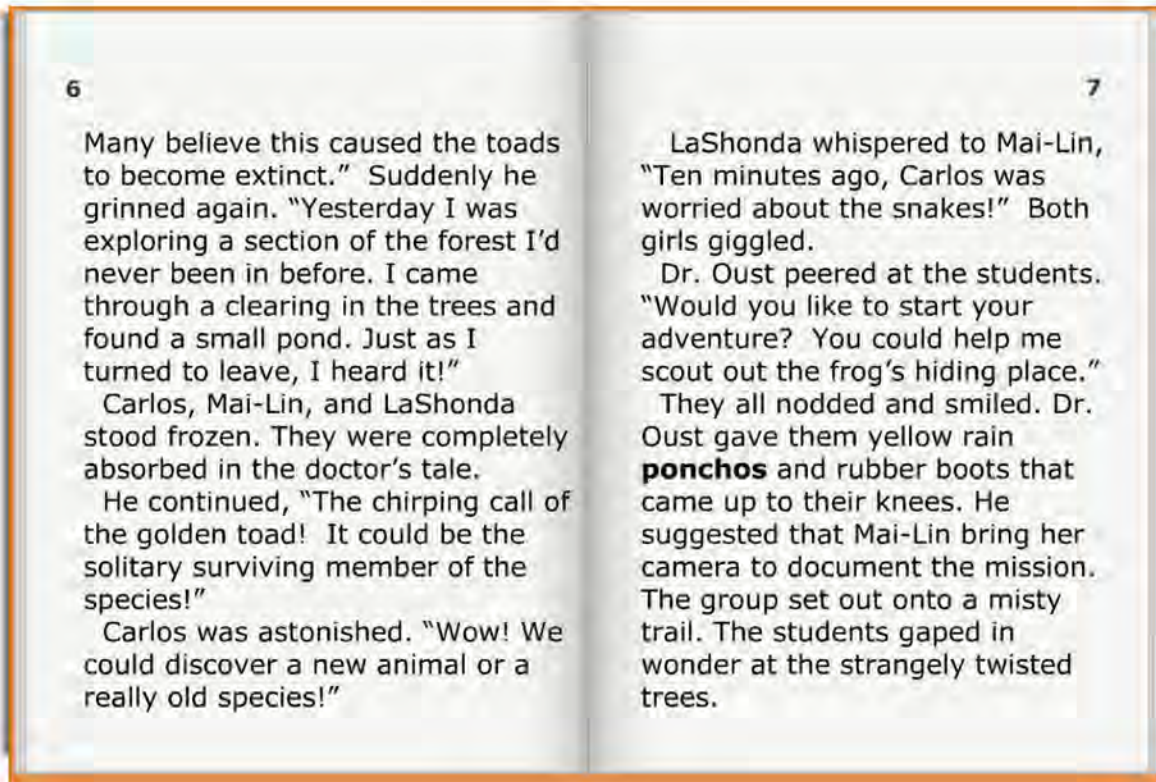

When you read a descriptive paragraph, it almost makes you feel like you're there. How does painting a picture in your mind help you understand the story?

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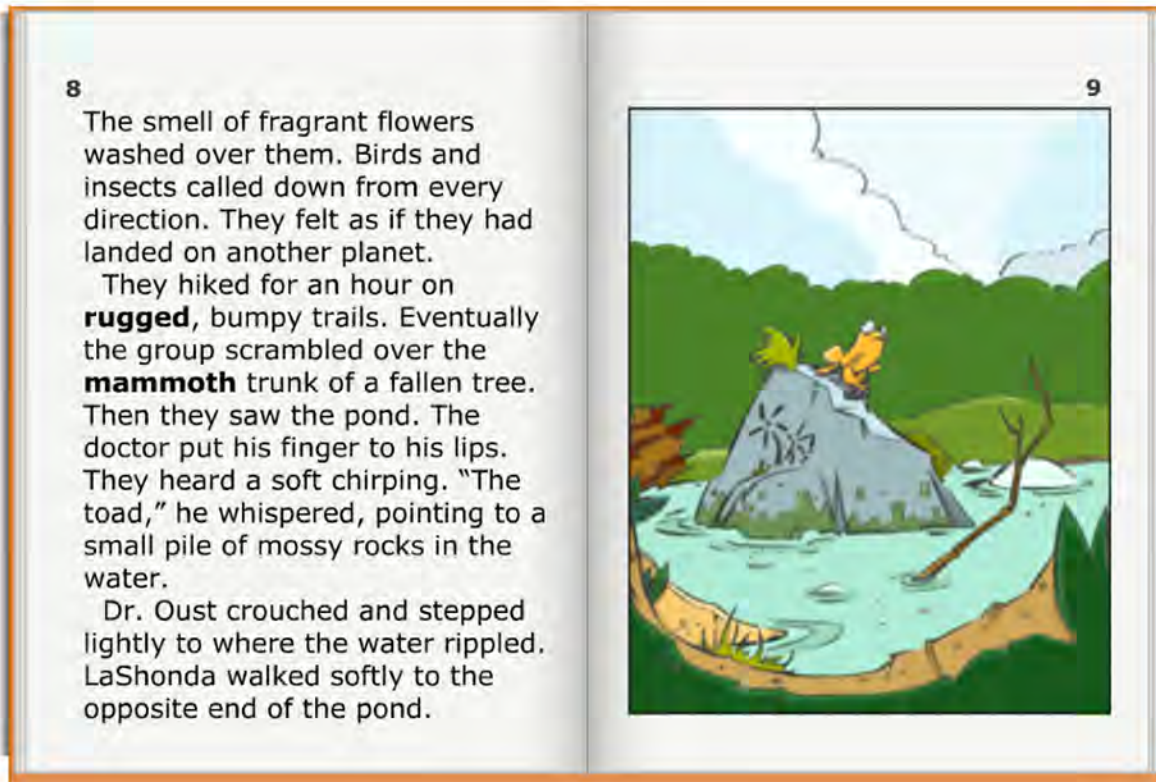

They seem to have heard the golden toad. What do you think will happen next?

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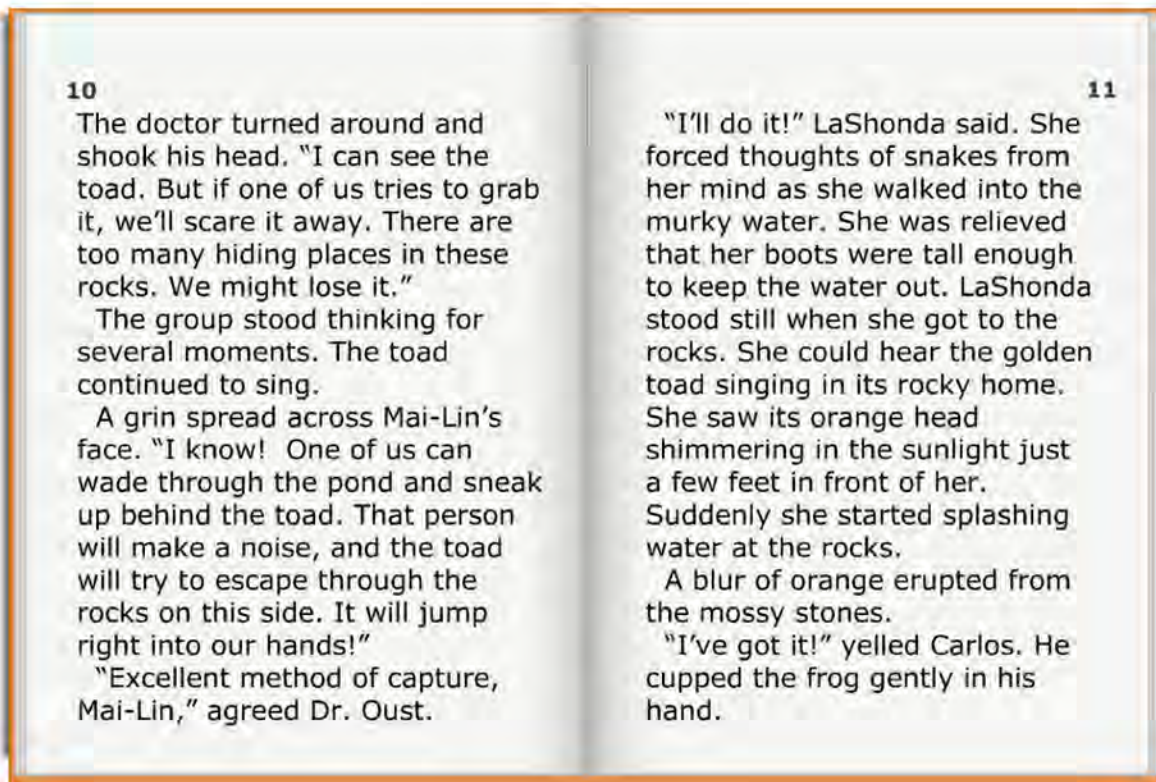

In splashing, the consonants "sh" represent one sound that is different from the individual letters : splash/ing.

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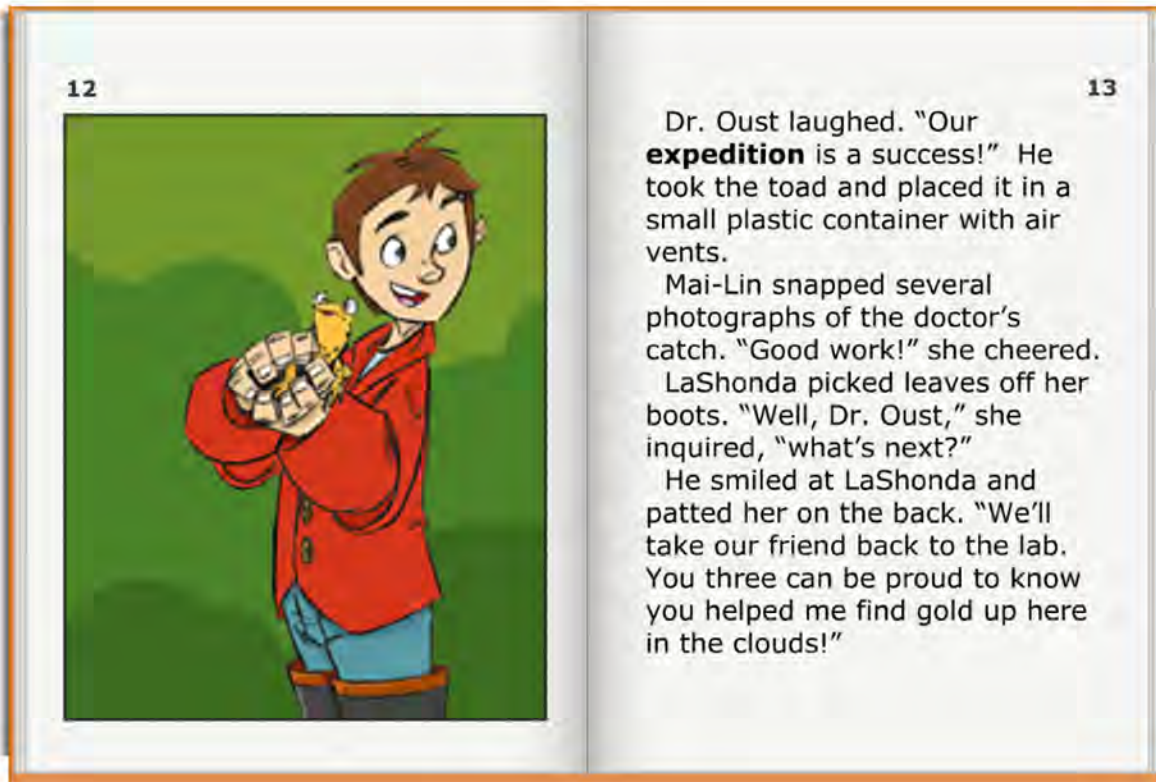
